- Do they seem genuinely interested in my project?





3. Site Visit

When you find a builder you like, visit a few of their completed projects and a few job sites currently under construction. Observe the condition of the site carefully and ask yourself:

- Is the site clean and safe to navigate?
- Are the plans easily accessible to all who need them?
- Are the vents, flooring, windows, and finishes being protected?
- Does the site look organized?
